Have you ever been rescued? May-be something simple like you forgot your keys and someone came to help or your car broke down and those friendly people from the AA or wherever, came to your rescue. There's always a real sense of relief and gratitude for those who respond to our calls for urgent help. Our Easter appeal this year is supporting the Midlands Air Ambulance. Since 1991 they have responded to more

than 72,000 missions. The Worcestershire Air Ambulance is stationed at Strensham and the Charity Vision is "Saving Lives by Saving Time, today, tomorrow and in the future"

The focus of our church Easter celebrations is always Jesus. The name Jesus means God is our salvation or our deliverer or God is our rescuer. Jesus said he was the light of the world and that he had come to bring us life in all its abundance. I am in need of such a Saviour to rescue me from death and darkness and despair and sin, to a place of eternal life and light and hope and forgiveness. Uganda Well Project Update: Many will know that FHBC has had links with Emmanuel Cathedral in Uganda for a number of years and this year, championed by our Green Team, we are raising money to help complete a water project at the Cathedral's Nursery/Primary School. The well has been dug, the water tank & electrical cables installed but the pump itself and a security building are still needed - about £1500.



We contributed to a similar project at Mvara Primary School which has now been running for 6 or 7 years and supplies water to meet all the school's needs, including drinking, cooking and for the toilet block. It's such a joy to see children able to turn on a tap to drink water safely! The new kitchen makes it easier to provide

porridge for morning break and a simple but nourishing lunch.

Seeing the benefits here has highlighted the significance & many blessings of having a clean water source.
